

Food Truck/Vendor Expectations

Any infractions may lead to being asked to leave the Dakota-Thurston County Fairgrounds. If you are asked to leave you will not be allowed back for future events.

- 1.) All trash from vendors must be taken to dumpsters by the Open Horse Arena (East side of Fairgrounds.) Green trashcans and barrels are reserved solely for consumer waste products.
 - a. Vehicles are not allowed on Vendor row to haul trash at any time.
- 2.) No vehicles are allowed into the Fairgrounds/Vendor Row after initial setup for any reason.
- 3.) Any Vendor arriving after Wednesday at 7:00 PM must make arrangements with the Fair Board prior to driving on vendor row.
- 4.) Any Vendor leaving before Sunday at 4:00 PM must make arrangements with the Fair Board prior to driving on vendor row.
- 5.) Vendor must set up in assigned spot. Any deviation from that must be approved by the Fair Board.
- 6.) There will not be power supplied by the Dakota-Thurston County Fair. All vendors must bring their own generator unless approved by the Fair Board.
- 7.) All vendors must have their required State issued food license. This is subject to inspection at any time.
- 8.) Overnight camping and/or pitched sleeping tents are not permitted on vendor row.

The Dakota-Thurston County Fair Board reserves the right to ask any vendor to move locations or leave the Fairgrounds at any time.

The Dakota-Thurston County Fair Board reserves the right to deny any vendor application.
